



## CONMUN 2023 COVID-19 Advisory

CONMUN takes the health and safety of our delegates and staff extremely seriously. In accordance with federal, provincial, and municipal health guidelines, we will be implementing the following COVID-19 advisory in order to limit the spread of the virus. Please note that this advisory is subject to change as public health guidelines may evolve.

- All delegates, faculty advisors and staff members are asked to assess their health daily, and to report to a Secretariat member if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms:
  - Sore throat, new or worsening cough
  - Runny nose, sneezing
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Temperature equal to or more than 38°C, feeling feverish, chills.
  - Fatigue or weakness, muscle, or body aches
  - Loss of smell or taste
  - Headache
  - Abdominal pain, diarrhea, and vomiting
- If an individual is experiencing symptoms, they will be provided a rapid test and asked to complete the Self-Declaration Form, which can be found on our website, and is linked [here](#).
- If a delegate, faculty advisor, or staff member tests positive during the conference, those deemed to be a close contact to the individual must follow provincial isolation guidelines as established by the relevant public health authorities.
- CONMUN reserves the right to implement or modify COVID-19 measures before or at any time during the conference in order to ensure the health and safety of participants and staff.
