



CONMUN 2022 COVID-19 Policy

CONMUN takes the health and safety of our delegates and staff extremely seriously. In accordance with federal, provincial, and municipal health guidelines, we will be implementing the following policies in order to ensure a safe conference for all. Please note that these policies are subject to change as public health guidelines evolve.

- Delegates and staff members must wear a mask at all times during the conference.
- All delegates and staff members must show proof of being adequately protected against COVID-19, as per Quebec public health guidelines.
- If a delegate has a doctor's note which exempts them from vaccination, please contact chargee.conmun@cg-aa.org.
- All delegates will be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken after 10:00am on March 29th, 2022 OR a positive COVID-19 test taken between 10 and 180 days before the conference. If delegates cannot access a testing facility or cannot pay for a test, please complete [the linked PDF](#) and upload it instead of your official results.
- Any delegate who experiences symptoms of COVID-19 must immediately report them to the secretariat using [the linked form](#).
- Delegations and individual delegates must submit their proof of vaccination/protection a negative test result and a list of their delegate names to chargee.conmun@cg-aa.org prior to 6:00pm on March 31st, 2022. Please only submit one email per delegation.
- If a delegate or staff members tests positive during the conference, those deemed to be a close contact to the individual, as per provincial guidelines, must partake in the remainder of committee sessions virtually and cannot attend any social events.
- CONMUN reserves the right to implement or modify COVID-19 measures before or at anytime during the conference in order to ensure the health and safety of participants and staff.
